Mr. Vincent E. "Cassanova" Barnhill, 60, passed away Saturday, April 9, 2017. Funeral services will be held 1:00 p.m., Hayes Chapel Missionary Baptist Church, Saturday, April 15, 2017. Burial in Homestead Memorial Gardens.

Vincent was born on August 24, 1956 to Maggie C. Barnhill and William C. Brown in Bethel North Carolina. Vincent received his formal education through the Pitt County Public School System and graduated North Pitt High School in 1975. During his four years at North Pitt he excelled in basketball becoming the leading scorer throughout his four-year tenure. It was at North Pitt when his coach nicknamed him "Casanova", a name that would follow him throughout his life. Vincent served his country by joining the U.S. Army in 1978. He served in the Field Artillery Corp at Fort Knox, Kentucky until his honorable discharge. Vincent "Vimp" departed his life on April 09, 2017. He was preceded in death by his loving mother Maggie C.
